Attachment AC-9

S92 EXCEPTIONS

The respondent may:

- (a) Do anything that is permitted by a Family Law Act order, a child protection order or a written agreement about child arrangements; or
- (b) Negotiate child arrangements by letter, email or text message; or
- (c) Communicate with a protected person through a lawyer or mediator; or
- (d) Arrange and/ or participate in counselling or mediation; or
- (e) Go to the home of a protected person, in the company of a police officer or a person chosen by the applicant, to collect personal property.

BUT ONLY IF the respondent does not commit family violence while doing so

S93 PROHIBITION

The respondent is prohibited from living with, spending time with or communicating with the child/ children.

RETURN OF PERSONAL PROPERTY (OF THE AFM)

The Court also orders that the respondent must arrange to return personal property belonging to the protected person(s) within 2 days of service of this order.

NOTE: The RESP's personal property can be collected through the inclusion of s92E and VicPol only deals with undisputed items of personal property (if there is a dispute parties are to go through the family law process)

ELIGIBILITY ASSESSMENT (COUNSELLING ORDER)

The Court also orders that the respondent attends an assessment for eligibility and counselling orders program.
