SUSPENSION OF FAMILY LAW ACT ORDERS

At the time of making this interim intervention order the Court has also made an order under s68R of the Family Law Act 1975.

The Court has ordered that the Family Law Act order dated <<dd/mm/yy>> is revived/ discharged/ varied/ suspended.

This order will end when the interim intervention order ends or 21 days from the date when the interim intervention order was made (whichever is earlier).

FIREARMS SUSPENSION (INTERIM ORDERS)

The Court also orders until further order, any firearms authority held by the respondent is suspended. The respondent must hand any firearms in his/ her possession to police immediately

WEAPONS SUSPENSION (INTERIM ORDERS)

The Court also orders until further order, any weapons approval or exemption held by the respondent is suspended. The respondent must hand any weapons in his/ her possession to police immediately

WEAPONS REVOCATION (FINAL ORDERS)

The Court also orders if the respondent has a weapons approval or a weapons exemption, it is revoked. The respondent must hand any weapons in his/ her possession to police immediately.

FIREARMS AUTHORITY CANCELLED (FINAL ORDERS)

The Court also orders if the respondent has a firearms authority, it is cancelled. The respondent must hand any firearms in his/ her possession to police immediately.
