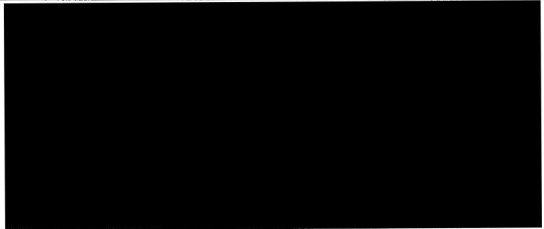




### Family violence services

- The majority of specific family violence services are funded from two Departmental output groups - housing assistance and child protection and family services.
- Through housing assistance, specific family violence services include:
  - **Crisis support and accommodation** – women’s refuges
  - **Transition support, which includes case management/outreach** and a component of the private rental brokerage program
  - **Telephone information and referral** – the statewide crisis service
  - **National Partnership Agreement on Homelessness (NPAH) funded activities:** such as Safe at Home, after hours support, men’s case management, Aboriginal family violence responses, which includes the operational funding of two Aboriginal refuges and Aboriginal legal support
  - **NPAH funded intensive case management:** for people with complex needs, as well as Aboriginal Victorians, women with a disability and women from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds
  - **Families at Home**
  - **Funding for peak bodies.**
- Through child protection and family services, specific family violence services include:
  - **Support for women and children** (counselling)
  - **Men’s family violence services**, including the men’s referral service, men’s behaviour change programs and intake services
  - **High risk responses, including Risk Assessment and Risk Management Panels**
  - **Indigenous family violence services**, including Healing and Time Out services and the Community Initiatives Fund
  - **Regional Integration Committees**
  - **Family violence risk assessment and management (CRAF)**
  - **Adolescent family violence programs**
  - **Women’s Information and Referral exchange**
  - **Men’s peak body.**
