I, PAUL DANIEL RUDD, Acting Inspector, Victoria Police, SAY:

- I have previously provided a written statement to the Royal Commission into Far Violence (Royal Commission), dated 27 July 2015.
- 2. I refer to the oral evidence I provided to the Royal Commission on 5 August 201! wish to make a correction to that evidence.
- 3. In my oral evidence to the Royal Commission I referred to the period of time between criminal charges are issued by police, and when the matter is first mention before the Magistrates' Court. In relation to charges that are issued by way of summons, I stated that the delay between a summons being issued to an accuse and the first mention before the court, was eleven weeks at Melbourne Magistrat Court and fourteen weeks at Dandenong Magistrates' Court.
- 4. After I provided this evidence to the Royal Commission, I was informed by a mer of the Victoria Police Dandenong Prosecutions Unit that, as at the start of Augus year, the delay between a summons being issued and the first mention before th Dandenong Magistrates' Court was six and a half weeks. Accordingly, I wish to correct my oral evidence before the Royal Commission to reflect that the correct period of delay between a summons being issued and the first mention of a matt Dandenong Magistrates' Court is six and a half weeks.
- I confirm that the relevant period stated for Melbourne Magistrates' Court, elever weeks, was and is correct.
