Methodology or any caveats/ assumptions

The above costing estimate is a very high level assessment that reflects MCV total annual expense budget against family violence related case loads, as a percentage of the entire caseload. In terms of caseloads, infringements are excluded (as they are high volume, and largely administrative).

MCV funding used in the estimate includes family violence program specific funding and a mix of funding components, some directly linked to core operations and others (ie capital works) that are not. The main assumption with the cost assessment is that the entire funding amount is necessary for the court to delivery its services, including those to family violence related cases. Another assumption is the % of family violence related cases in the criminal and victims of crime assistance tribunal streams, which is estimated at 20% based on current VPOL and MCV data sources.
