From [redacted] my life (and my families) was destroyed by a spurious Intervention Order.

I had the I.V.O. taken out on behalf of my children's father (we had been in a on/off relationship for [redacted] years) and his new girl-friend.

She was [redacted] and a [redacted]. I had my children age [redacted] & [redacted] taken from me, [redacted]

[redacted] lost life long friends and wasn't allowed to attend [redacted] funerals of people I was close to.

And the list goes on for me, this doesn't include the trauma to my children, brothers & sisters Mum and extended family. I have had trouble since [redacted] being a productive member of society, I've been to numerous councilors

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couldn't function to work for years and have NO respect for police and the justice system.

Now I am homeless ( [REDACTED] ) and still have flash-backs and become distressed when I hear of anything to do with I.V.O.<sup>s</sup> in the media. For me to make any sense of what happened to me I need to tell my story to the Royal Commission.

I demand compulsory counselling with the issue of every I.V.O. for the defendant. And perjury charges for those who bring false & spurious orders before the courts. I had a never-ending I.V.O. against me which was only lifted in [REDACTED]
