Thank you for the opportunity of making a submission to The Royal Commission.

I was concerned at Media reports, that non high profile victims; may not have been represented. That The Commission would rely on Police, Agencies; and the Legal System to the greater part.

This Group has been exposed in letting down Rosie Battie, thousands of women; hundreds of men – including myself. This Group has contributed to this unsatisfactory state of affairs.

My involvement started 26 years ago. At first, and then progressing; through stages of immaturity, inexperience, naivety, anti-social behaviour, bipolar, post-traumatic stress; and finally Criminal behaviour.

If possible, I can tender documentation; relating to :

- Doctors' Certificate from being assaulted
- Bouncing Cheques.
- Proceedings from – not paying bills & fines  
 ( Creditors, Civic Compliance, ATO; Sherriff's' Office etc. )
- Defaulting on Credit
- False reports to Police
- Retractions and admissions to The Magistrates Court
- Being Stalked and Blackmailed
- Convictions for breaching Intervention Orders and  
 Civic Compliance reoffending
- Centrelink Fraud – Domestic
- Centrelink Childcare Fraud – Business
- Australian Federal Police Search Warrant
- Threatening Behaviour and Property Damage

I myself have to plead guilty to delivering my son's [REDACTED] magazine, to his schools' reception office. I am currently facing other allegations.

If nothing else, other men can learn from my reactions and behaviour. Hopefully The Royal Commission can find a positive contribution from my experience(s).
